

2008 – 2009 Selection Criteria for the *State Superintendent's Schools of Promise*

All public elementary and secondary schools administering Ohio Achievement and Ohio Graduation Tests and receiving a local report card rating were considered. Schools were selected based on the following criteria:

Poverty: The school served 40 percent or more economically disadvantaged students, as reported in EMIS for the 2008-2009 school year.

Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP): The school met AYP for the 2008-2009 school year.

Graduation Rate: The school's graduation rate was at least 85 percent for the 2007-2008 school year.¹

Student Performance on Ohio Achievement Tests (OAT) and Ohio Graduation Tests (OGT) in reading or mathematics:

All Students

1. At least 75 percent of all students in each of the tested grade levels (3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10) passed the 2008-2009 OAT and/or OGT in reading or mathematics. At least 85 percent of eleventh-graders passed the 2008-2009 OGT in reading or mathematics.
2. At least 65 percent of all students in each of the tested grade levels (3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10) passed the 2007-2008 OAT and/or OGT in reading or mathematics.

Low-Income Subgroup Performance²

Each Tested Grade

1. At least 75 percent of the students in each subgroup in each of the tested grades (3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10) passed the 2008-2009 OAT and/or OGT in reading or mathematics.
2. At least 85 percent eleventh-grade in each subgroup passed the OGT in reading or mathematics.

Racial and Ethnic Subgroup Performance³

Each Tested Grade

1. At least 75 percent of the students in each subgroup in each of the tested grades (3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10) passed the 2008-2009 OAT and/or OGT in reading or mathematics.
2. At least 85 percent eleventh-grade in each subgroup passed the OGT in reading or mathematics.

Value-Added: The school received a "Met" or "Above" for the 2008-2009 Value-Added Composite Score.

¹ The graduation rate only applies to schools where there were at least five students who were supposed to graduate in 2007-2008.

² When evaluating test results, only grade levels with five or more test takers who met the low-income criteria were considered.

³ When evaluating test results, only racial and ethnic groups with five or more test takers were considered.
