In order to keep students and staff safe we have made the decision to follow the guidelines of our local district; instruction will be 100% online for all students through the remainder of the first semester. Based on the guidelines of the local health department we will reassess in December/January to determine if conditions are safer for students to return for in-person instruction. In addition to this, there will not be any winter sports for the 2020-2021 school year. This decision did not come easily, but the health of our staff and students is our top priority. Here are a few reminders for how to help your student continue to succeed with online learning:

- Students need to continue logging into Concept SIS every day before 12pm. <https://grades.hsas.org>. If you need your login information or your students contact the office.
- Students need to log into Google Classroom every morning by 9. Teachers will have assignments and lectures posted by then.
- Teachers have office hours Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday that are specifically for tutoring or further explanation.
- Teachers are available via email and video conferencing.
